# Rat monoclonal anti mouse EDAR (ectodysplasin receptor)

**Preparation:** This antibody was produced from a hybridoma (mouse myeloma fused with spleen cells from a rat immunized with mouse **recombinant Extracellular Domain of EDAR**).

**Formulation and Storage:** The IgG fraction of culture supernatant was purified by Protein A/G affinity chromatography and lyophilized from a 0.2 µm filtered solution in phosphate-buffered saline (PBS). Lyophilized samples are stable for 2 years from date of receipt when stored at -70°C.

**Reconstitution:** Reconstitute the antibody with 200 µl sterile PBS (final concentration 500µg/ml). Reconstituted antibody can be aliquoted and stored frozen at < -20 for at least for six months without detectable loss of activity. **Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.**

**Specificity:** This antibody detects mouse **EDRA** in Western blotting and cross reacts with human EDAR.
